

Introduction

This Wool Felt Cameo was inspired from the works of Jane Austen, an English novelist of romantic fiction from the early 1800's. The silhouette is believed to be that of Jane Austen.

The kit can be assembled with the Silhouette or you can embroider initials or a special message instead. We hope you find inspiration in these patterns to bring your own unique brand of style into your home.

Kit Contents

Qty	Item
6	Large Scalloped Ovals
3	Medium Ovals Various Colors
3	Small Scalloped Ovals
1	Floss
1	Embroidery Needle

Stitches Needed

Running Stitch

Insert the needle from the rear side of the piece through to the front. A ¼” stitch is made with a 1/16” gap. Continue to form the design and then knot on the back side.



Blanket Stitch

Thread a needle with floss and knot one of the two ends. The starter stitch begins between the two layers of wool felt. The needle is inserted between two layers, then down through the bottom layer and up over the tail. Pull the thread tight which will set the knot between the layers.

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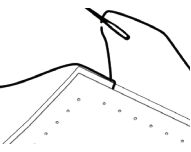
Blanket Stitch

Thread a needle with floss and knot one of the two ends. The starter stitch begins between the two layers of wool felt. The needle is inserted between two layers, then down through the bottom layer and up over the tail. Pull the thread tight which will set the knot between the layers.

Insert the needle down into the fabric, through both layers, and up inside the loop. Then, pull tight.

Repeat traveling along the edge of the fabric until you have completed the edging.

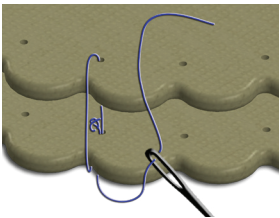
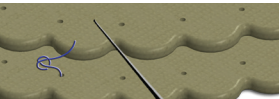
The stitching should be evenly spaced and have the loop along the seam between the two felt pieces.



Scallop Stitch

This stitch hides the loop between layers otherwise it is very similar to a blanket stitch. Start with the knot between the layers and the tom layer.

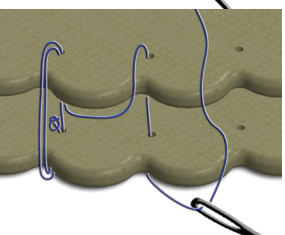
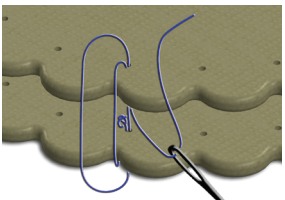
Run the needle around the outside back to the top and down



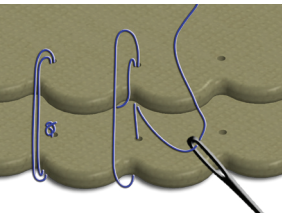
through both layers ending up out the bottom just like when you did the first step.

Repeat for a second loop but end back up in the middle where the knot was.

Run the needle between the layers to the next lobe, then into the top, through both layers and out the bottom.



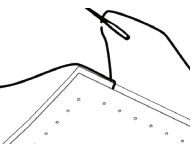
Run the needle in the top, through both layers and out the middle forming a second loop in the same holes. Then continue on around the oval.



Insert the needle down into the fabric, through both layers, and up inside the loop. Then, pull tight.

Repeat traveling along the edge of the fabric until you have completed the edging.

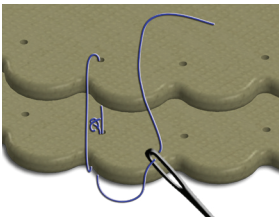
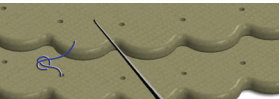
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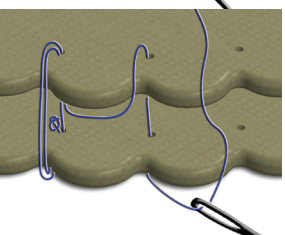
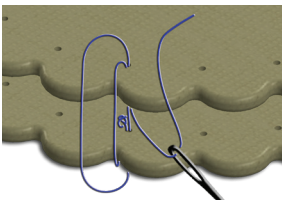
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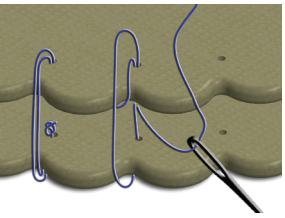
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Run the needle in the top, through both layers and out the middle forming a second loop in the same holes. Then continue on around the oval.



Instructions

Design Side

You can either embroider your own design on the small oval or use a running stitch to attach the Silhouette.

Assembly

Using a scallop stitch attach the small cameo to the colored mid sized cameo.

Repeat to attach the colored cameo to the large cameo.

Repeat to attach the 2nd large cameo to the back of the assembly.

Care

All of the wool felt in our kits is a blend of 20-35% wool. Dry cleaning is recommended for cleaning. To press wool felt, use a steam iron on high.
